

Singing Contest Regulations (Semi-Final) 2008-2009

1. The Students' Association has the sole right of arranging the order of performance. Participants will be notified of the schedule at least 3 working days before the competition. (Please refer to the SA board or SA homepage for the most updated information.)
2. Each participant can participate only once in solo-singing but at most two in other categories.
3. For group-singing, each group should comprise 2 to 5 participants.
For class-singing, each class should comprise at least half of the class (excluding those who solely play musical instruments.)
4. Participants have to pay \$10 registration fee when submitting the application form. The fee will be refunded on completion of the competition.
5. 3 sets of lyrics should be attached when submitting the application form.
6. Participants are allowed to use the piano in the hall to play the music. If other musical instruments are needed, participants have to bring along those instruments by themselves.
7. Each group /class will only be given 5 microphones at most in group-singing/ class-singing.
8. Participants are not allowed to go down the stage during performance.

Participants will have a mark penalty for failing to comply with the following rules:

9. Participants must register at the counter 20 minutes before their performance.
10. The music of each song should not be longer than 3 minutes in all solo-singing, group-singing and class-singing.
11. Make up and accessories are not allowed. Participants may also have their names recorded if they wear make-up and accessories.

Participants will have to perform without music if:

12. Participants fail to hand in a CD in WMA or MP3 format that contains only the music of the song to be performed during registration (i.e. 20 minutes before the scheduled performance).
13. The CD submitted contains the music of more than one song.
14. The CD submitted is a pirated CD.

Participants will not be allowed to have their performance if:

15. Participants are not in full school uniform.
16. Participants perform a song different from that stated on the application form.
17. Their songs contain improper/indecent wordings.
